- Responsibility to ensure that the College implements effective risk management strategies and maintains compliance with regulations to safeguard the wellbeing of students and staff.

Reporting to the St Michael's College Board Adelaide, the Finance, Audit and Risk Management (FARM) Committee currently comprises voluntary members of the St Michael's Board, College staff and volunteers. The committee meets on a monthly basis to discuss the Financial and Risk management strategies for the College. Duties include:
